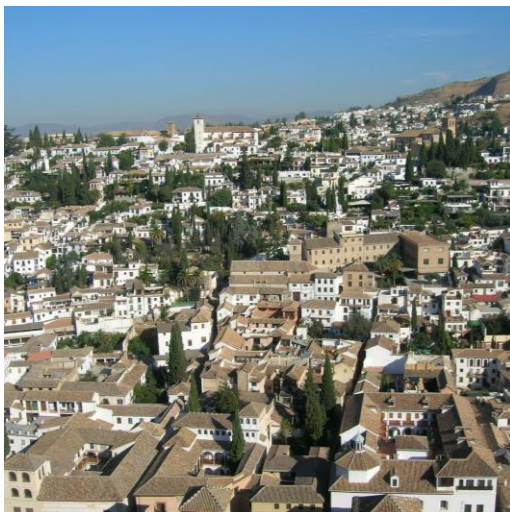

Arriving in Granada

Granada is the capital city of the province of the same name, located in southern eastern Spain, between the shores of the Mediterranean and the Andalusian hinterland. The city is located at the foot of Sierra Nevada, the highest mountain range of the Iberian Peninsula.

Motorways:

A-92, connecting the city with Almería and Seville, and

A-44, linking with A-4 in Bailén, leading to Madrid.



Granada National Airport has good connections with other Spanish cities like **Madrid, Barcelona, Bilbao, Gran Canaria, Oviedo, Melilla, Palma de Mallorca or Tenerife**), but there are few international flights to Granada: **Amsterdam and Paris**.. There is a Bus service from the Granada Airport 30 minutes after every flight arrival

The nearest airport with a fuller range of international flight destinations is **Malaga National Airport**. Buses from Malaga to Granada are every one to two hours and take only between 1,5 and 2 hours. There are also two buses direct from the Malaga Airport to Granada. Clarification notice: On October 1, 2025, Granada's Low Emission Zone (LEZ) comes into effect. The regulation restricts access for vehicles without an environmental label from the Spanish Directorate-General for Traffic (DGT), particularly gasoline cars registered before 2001 and diesel vehicles registered before 2006. Vehicles with B, C, ECO, or Zero labels are allowed unrestricted access.
