The EASP is a reference institution in Spain and Europe for education, research, and innovation in public health and health systems, with a strong international projection.

What do we do?

The EASP is a center for training, research, consultancy, and international cooperation in the fields of public health, healthcare management, and social services.

The EASP works closely with the Andalusian Health Service, the Spanish Ministry of Health, the World Health Organization (WHO), the European Union, and multiple international networks.

- ▶ **Training:** postgraduate programs (like the Master in Public Health and Health Management, Europubhealth+, and specialized diplomas), continuous professional education, and e-learning.
- ▶ **Research & Innovation:** applied research in health systems, public health, equity, and health policies.
- ▶ **Consultancy & Technical Support:** advising public administrations and international organizations on health system strengthening, evaluation, and policy development.
- ▶ **International Cooperation:** projects with WHO, the European Commission, and countries in Latin America, Africa, and the Mediterranean region.

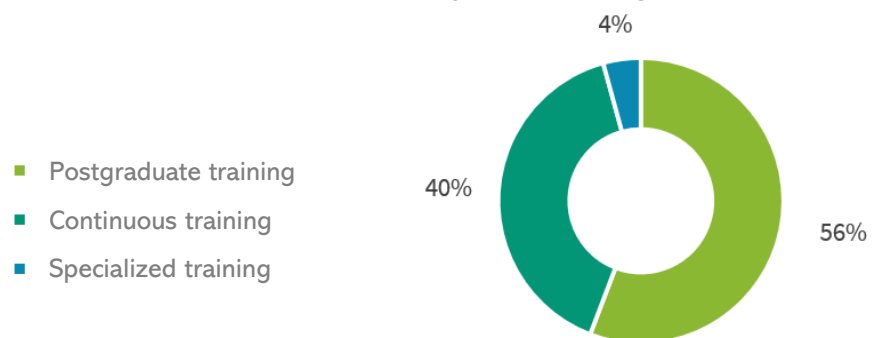

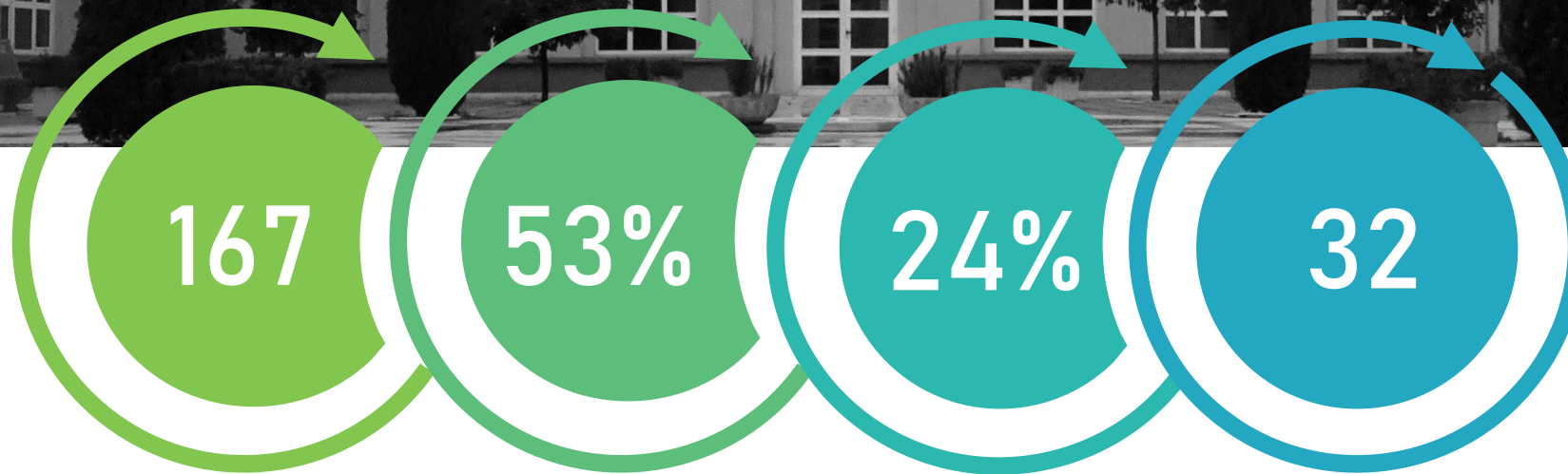

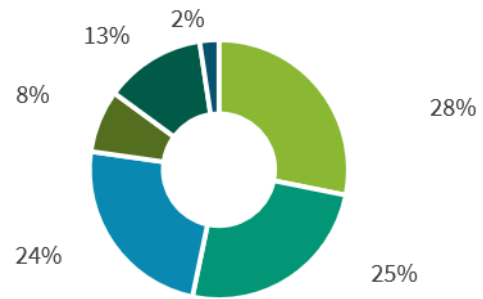

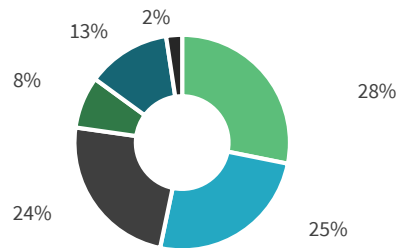

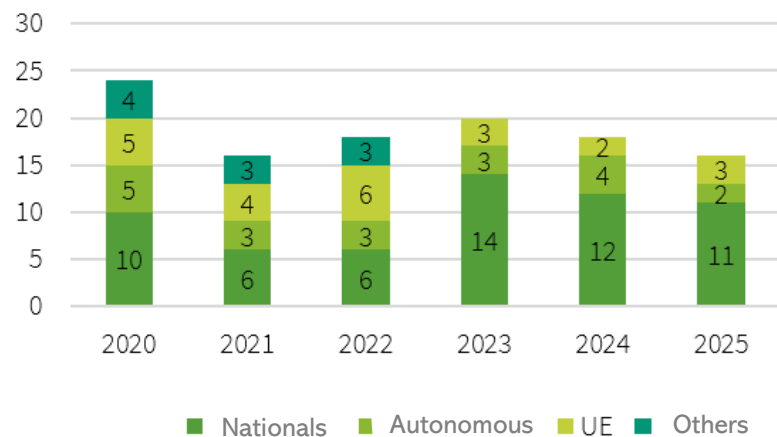

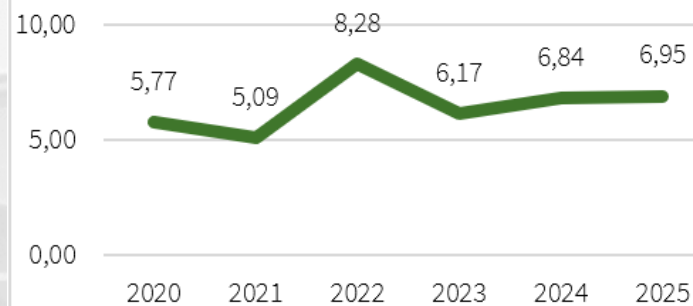

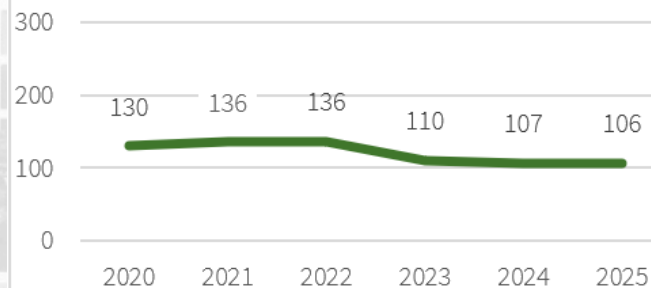
*Evolution of the number of active projects by area.

The Granada Cancer Registry (RCG) is a population-based cancer registry, which began its activity in 1985 as a project of the Ministry of Health and Consumer Affairs of the Andalusian Regional Government and it is attached to the Andalusian School of Public Health.

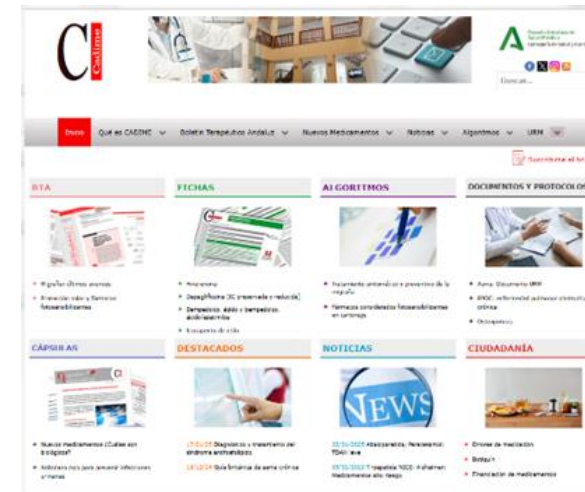

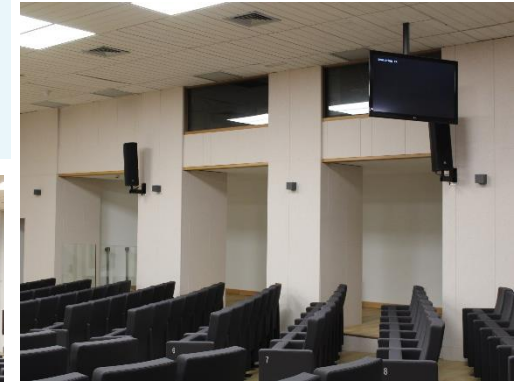

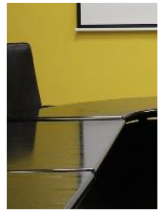
